**FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENT APPLICATION**

**ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS**

The following entrance requirements have been established for the purpose of maintaining both the academic and spiritual qualities of the Liberty Christian Schools student body. Your cooperation in completing these requirements is appreciated.

1. All completed forms (listed below) must be turned in to the office.
  - a. Application for Admission
  - b. Statement of Cooperation
  - c. Personal letter by the student
  - d. Lifestyle Responsibilities Questionnaire
  - e. Copy of Report Card
  - f. Current Immunizations Required
2. The student must provide a copy of recent achievement test scores (e.g., CTBS, SAT). If no test scores are available, he/she must take the Wide Range Achievement Test and should score within six months of his/her present grade level in the three areas tested - spelling, mathematics, and reading.
3. Prerequisites to grade level subjects must be completed. This will be determined from a copy of the student's transcript.
4. A personal letter must be written by the student as described below:
  - a. Essay on "Why I Wish To Attend Liberty Christian Schools";
  - b. Essay should include a personal testimony and spiritual history.
5. An interview by an administrator with the student and his/her parents will be scheduled.
6. Only students in grades 7 - 12 may be admitted.

After all the above items have been completed, the final acceptance or rejection of the student will be made by the Admissions Review Committee. All new high school students will be on probation for one semester, at which time the Admissions Review Committee will once again need to approve the student's continuation of enrollment.

## FINANCES

### REGISTRATION (NON-REFUNDABLE)

The registration fee, which accompanies the completed application, is:

These fees are used for ordering books and supplies and are **not refundable** unless the student is not accepted for admission.

### TUITION

Tuition is figured on a yearly basis; therefore if a student is enrolled for the full year, enrollment in our school constitutes a contract for obligation of tuition payment for the entire school year. You may pay the tuition in ten (10) equal payments, the first being due AUGUST 1<sup>st</sup>. **REMEMBER** - The first payment is always August 1<sup>st</sup>.

For students who enroll or depart during the school year, the tuition will be figured on a pro-rated basis, with the parent paying only for that portion of time that the student is actually enrolled in school. For students NOT re-enrolling for the following school year or departing during a current school year, the tuition must be paid in full before records will be released.

**FOR ALL PARENTS - PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING:** Upon acceptance of the student described on the attached application, we hereby agree to accept all rules and regulations of the school and authorize the school administration to exercise such disciplinary measures as may be deemed necessary and proper. If the circumstances are such that routine discipline is insufficient, we understand that the administration reserves the right to administer corporal punishment.

We will give active support to the school program in every way and strive to be regular in attendance at parent meetings and other school functions to which parents are invited.

We agree that our child may participate in all regular school functions including field trips away from the school premises, and we absolve the school from liability to us or our child because of any injury which may occur to our child at school or during any school activity.

We understand that the school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not respect and maintain the school's spiritual and academic standards.

We have read the religious instruction section of the student handbook and agree to these concepts being taught to our child.

We agree that if our child should become involved in any trouble or if we disagree with any policy set by the school, we will in no case complain to any other party, and in the spirit of meekness, will register only necessary complaints with the teacher or administration (Matthew 18:15-17). If the complaint is with a teacher, we will go directly to that teacher before taking the complaint to the administration.

We understand that assessments will be made to cover damage to school property (including window breakage, abuse of books, etc). We understand also that some fees may be charged for courses or activities that require extra financial expense.

We agree to pay all of our financial obligations to Liberty Christian Schools on or before the due date. Financial obligations shall include, but are not limited to, tuition as set forth in the tuition schedule. We understand that our annual tuition is payable in ten (10), eleven (11), or twelve (12) equal monthly installments. The first tuition payment is **always due on August 1st**.

We understand that all tuition payments are due and payable on the first of each month, after which a 10% late fee will be assessed on the unpaid balance for payments not made by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.

**Lifestyle Responsibilities Questionnaire**

As a Christian school, Liberty Christian is committed to providing a "Christian Education for Life and Service." It is our conviction that learning and the Christian faith are inseparable. We are committed to the Bible as our standard of faith and practice. We believe that the Christian life is positive rather than negative. However, we also believe that it is in the best interest of the school to be specific with respect to certain standards.

Liberty Christian students are responsible to refrain from practices which are biblically condemned. In addition, students are responsible for upholding behavioral standards which exist for the betterment of the whole community. These require a member of the Liberty Christian student body to abstain from the possession and use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco, and illegal drugs. The Liberty Christian family refrains from all morally degrading aspects of the theater, entertainment media, and literature. Students are responsible to use care in their choice of entertainment. Grace Baptist students are also responsible for being faithful in church attendance, chapel and classes. All applicants accepted, will be supplied with a Student Manual. It is suggested that you read it carefully before enrolling.

School standards are designed to promote a community atmosphere conducive to growth. The school requires adherence to certain expectations in life style by all students--expectations which have come to be accepted as desirable standards of conduct by most Christian communities. While it is recognized that some may not have personal convictions wholly in accord with these responsibilities and standards, the purposes and ideals underlying them necessitate the student's willingness to modify his/her own personal conduct while a member of the student body, fully understanding that this is in the best interest of the academic community he/she has chosen to join.
