DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

The Bible curriculum of the Liberty Christian School is commensurate with the teaching of historic Christianity. The following basic doctrines are stressed throughout the school program.

- 1. The school teaches the plenary, verbal inspiration of the Holy Scriptures, both the Old and New Testaments.
- 2. God is One, existing in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 3. God in each of the three persons is eternal.
- 4. Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, and is true God and true man.
- 5. Man was created in the image of God. He sinned and thereby incurred, in addition to physical death, spiritual death, which is separation from God. All human beings are born with a sinful nature.
- 6. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, His ascension into heaven, and His present role as High Priest and Advocate.
- 7. The personal return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ will be for His church and the establishment of His earthly kingdom.
- 8. The bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust will be for the everlasting blessedness of the saved and the everlasting, conscious punishment of the lost.
- 9. All who receive, by faith, the Lord Jesus Christ, are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become the children of God with eternal security.
- 10. Satan is a real personality.
- 11. Those who are believers in the Lord Jesus Christ are called to a holy walk in their everyday lives.
- 12. Obedience to the Biblical commands to be separated unto God, from worldliness, is expected of the Christian.
- 13. Civil government is of divine appointment for the interests and good order of human society. Officials and those in authority are to be prayed for and conscientiously honored or obeyed, except in things explicitly opposed to the will of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who is the only Lord of the conscience.
